The Parris Foundation: S.T.E.M.ulating Minds (TPF) is dedicated to promoting educational opportunities and fostering awareness in S.T.E.M. via scholarships and free extended learning programs for underrepresented youth. Our marquee program, S.T.E.M.ulating Minds, combines fun, interactive activities with tutoring to enhance in-school learning. We believe that attracting young people to S.T.E.M. is the key to closing the achievement gap.

In 2009, the foundation set out to provide scholarships to students from disadvantaged backgrounds who were pursuing S.T.E.M. degrees. But we quickly found that a limited number of these students were interested in STEM disciplines. So in 2012, TPF launched S.T.E.M.ulating Minds for underrepresented youth in middle school to nurture an interest and passion in science from an early age. We later expanded to high school as our students got older and stayed in our program.

Each year, more than 100 students participate in free weekly Saturday instruction, take advantage of one-on-one tutoring, and receive scholarships to pursue a higher education in S.T.E.M. Core to the foundation's mission are the many volunteers who passionately guide students to that "Ah-ha!" moment and inspire enthusiasm for topics that kids might otherwise find inaccessible. And it's working! The foundation has given out dozens of scholarships and continues to nurture and support a diverse group of future S.T.E.M. leaders.
